Description

Bias is disproportionate weight in favor of or against one thing, person, or group compared with another, usually in a way considered to be unfair.

Biases can be learned by watching <u>cultural</u> contexts. People may develop biases toward or against an individual, an <u>ethnic group</u>, a sexual or gender identity, a nation, a religion, a <u>social class</u>, a political party, theoretical paradigms and ideologies within academic domains, or a species.[1] Biased means one-sided, lacking a neutral viewpoint, or not having an <u>open mind</u>. Bias can come in many forms and is related to <u>prejudice</u> and <u>intuition</u>.[2]

In science and engineering, a bias is a <u>systematic error</u>. <u>Statistical bias</u> results from an unfair <u>sampling</u> of a population, or from an <u>estimation</u> process that does not give accurate results on average.
