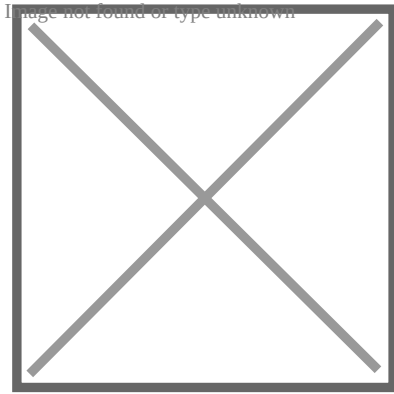




## State Terrorism as a tool for social control
